Northern Forest Community Recreation Grants Winter 2023

The Center seeks proposals from volunteer-led organizations working to increase local participation in outdoor recreation. Projects should:

- Reduce physical, financial, and social barriers to participating in outdoor recreation
- Use outdoor recreation to address public health concerns
- Embrace principles of sustainability and natural resource engagement and stewardship

Criteria: Preference will be given to projects that will be significantly impacted by the scale of funding available and meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrated community support
- Visible or quantifiable outcomes within six months of award
- Clear implementation plan
- Committed matching funds

Funding Available: Requests should range between \$500 and \$2,500. We anticipate making up to 15 awards.

Sample Projects: This list is illustrative only; proposals for additional project types are welcome.

- Recreation equipment for lending to community members
- Maps and trail signage
- Summer outdoor programs
- Transportation to outdoor recreation locations

Eligibility: Volunteer-led non-profits and municipal groups are eligible for funding. Projects must occur within the established Northern Forest counties, as shown on the map below. Contact us with questions about eligibility.


Deadline: March 31.
